

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

Typically Developing Children




Low Warmth and High Criticism

My child doesn't mean to do the wrong thing.


My child has a good heart

My child deliberately does awful things.


My child takes pleasure in my distress.







Shifting of cognitions Through audio coaching



## Using AI to detect attributions

One study by Chen et al. (2023) tested the diagnostic accuracy of GPT-4 and ChatGPT when specific diagnostic prompts were provided for the AI to identify thinking errors in written transcripts.

Found that GPT-4 was more accurate than ChatGPT, consistent accuracy when examining agreement rates with human evaluators
