## Proposal to Change CSE Thesis Assessment and Management Policies

Background: The faculty has recently approved faculty-wide undergraduate thesis assessment guidelines and thesis management policies. This is to be implemented by each school.

## Summary of Changes:

## • On Assessment

- Thesis A to be marked based on 70% report, 30% presentation
  - presentation due Week 7 (req: attend 4 seminars, attendance sheet)
  - thesis A report due Week 12 Tuesday
- Thesis B to be marked based on 80% report, 15% demo, 5% summary presentation
  - demo + summary presentation due Week 11
    - (marking to be done by Wk 11)
  - thesis B report due Week 13 Tuesday
  - thesis showcase (top 20 from the demo+summary presentation) Week
    13 Thursday
  - note summary presentation could be a poster, a video, 500-word abstract, or presentation slides. All summary presentations to be in PDF (e.g., a video link in a PDF file). To be collated as a digital archive of CSE theses every semester.
- All assessment tasks to be completed by the assessor and supervisor.
- Thesis A (10%) + Thesis B (90%)

## On Policy

- Failing Thesis A must re enrol Thesis A (FL recorded)
- o Failing Thesis B
  - re-enrol A/B again, new project/supervisor re-enrol for Thesis B, same project/supervisor (Thesis A twice, FL recorded)
  - student does further work, re-submit thesis B (max 6 weeks), mark capped at 50%
- Late policy
  - -5 marks off the actual thesis mark for every day late.
  - max 6 weeks after deadline
- Discrepancy amongst thesis marks
  - <= 10 marks, take the unweighted average</p>
  - > 10 marks two markers to come to an agreement on a final mark. If it is not possible, a third assessor could be used. Take an unweighted average of the three marks.
